



December 1 program: Bird Brains!

How "mindful" and intelligent are birds? How do we know? Laura will talk about a lot of recent and even brand new research:

- Chickadees selectively allow brain neurons to die to be replaced with new ones so they can forget useless information
- Magpies recognize themselves in a mirror's reflection
- A variety of birds use tools, and some actually know how to make tools
- Some corvids are conscious of what they know and what they don't.

Laura will explain what we're learning, how we're figuring it out, and why it's so hard for people to give up their old ideas about birds operating far more out of instinct than learning and reason.
