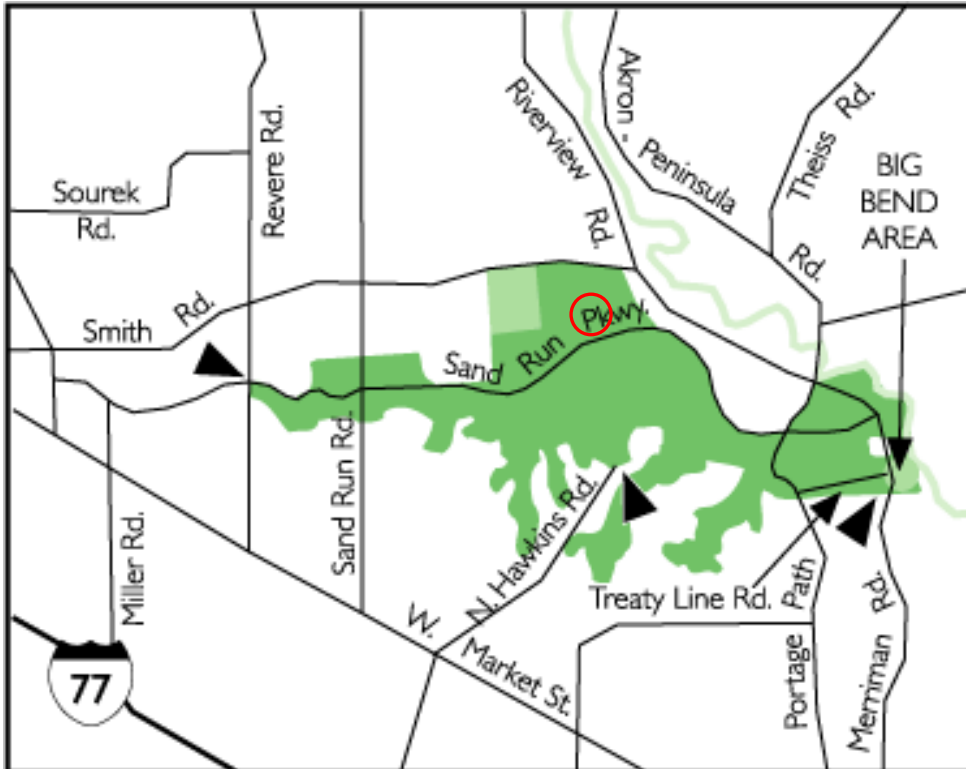


GAAS meetings are held at the Mingo Lodge within Summit County Sand Run Metro Park  
Sand Run Metro Park is located in northwest Akron in the Merriman Valley



- Approximate location of Mingo Lodge within Sand Run Metro Park is shown by the red circle located around the "P" of "Pkwy."

**Detour route** (refer to map)

At times during bad weather, the West entrance may be closed at the intersection of Sand Run Pkwy and Sand Run Road.

- The detour route is to turn left at the intersection and continue up the hill to Smith Road.
- Turn right at Smith Road, and then right at Riverview Road at the bottom of the steep hill.
- Continue to Portage Path and turn right at the light.
- The Park entrance is 0.5 mile on the right at Sand Run Pkwy.
- Refer to the East entrance directions below.

**From I-77**

**From the North:**

- Exit at Ghent Road and turn south (right) onto Ghent Road.
- Continue for approximately 1.6 miles until Sand Run Pkwy intersects Ghent Road on the left (after 3 lights).
- Follow Sand Run Pkwy for approximately 1.0 mile until it crosses Revere Road (at the 2<sup>nd</sup> light).
- This is the west entrance to Sand Run Metro Park. (Refer to the West entrance directions below)

**From the South:**

- Exit at Miller Road and continue straight on Miller Road until it dead-ends into Sand Run Pkwy (after 2 lights).
- Turn right onto Sand Run Pkwy.
- Follow Sand Run Pkwy for approximately 1.0 mile until it crosses Revere Road (at the 2<sup>nd</sup> light).
- This is the west entrance to Sand Run Metro Park. (Refer to the West entrance directions below)

**West entrance to Sand Run Metro Park:**

- If there is a "Road Closed" sign, please refer to the Detour map and directions given above.
- Mingo Pavilion is approximately 2.0 miles into the park.
- The pavilion is after both the first traffic light and the small fording stream that crosses the parkway road.
- The sign for the entrance drive to the pavilion is a small sign on the left.

**East entrance to Sand Run Metro Park:**

- If there is a "Road Closed" sign, this means that the ford is closed, but the Mingo Shelter is still accessible.
- Mingo Pavilion is approximately 1.1 miles into the park.
- The sign for the entrance drive to the pavilion is a small sign on the right.
